- Public & Organizational Engagement

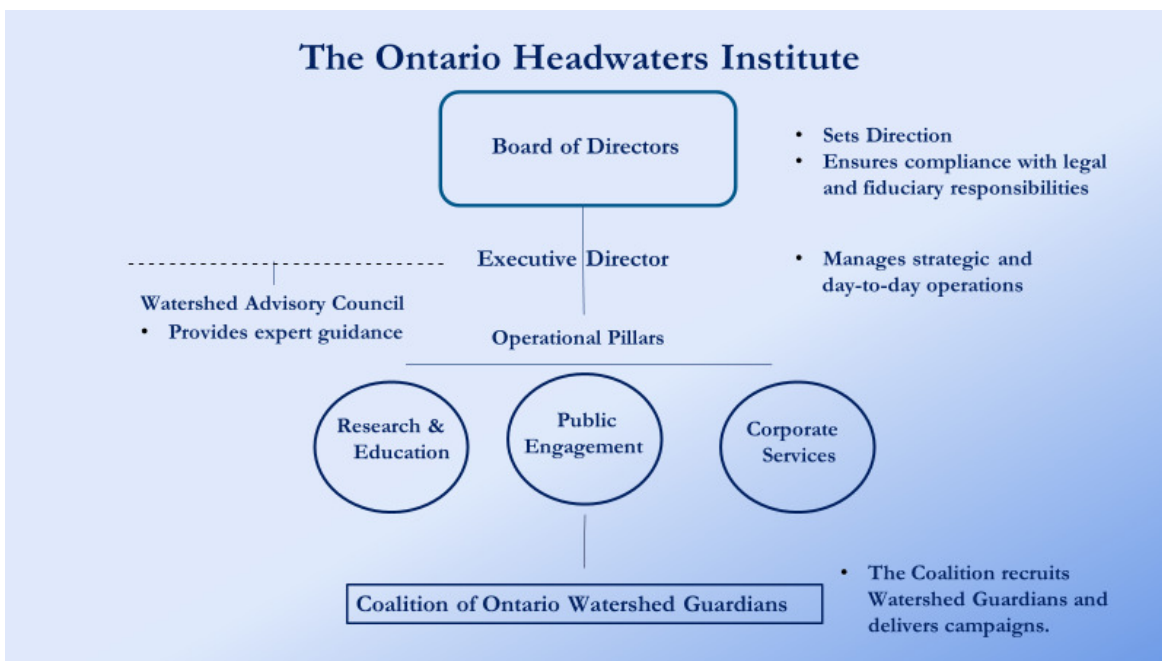
